

## Notice to E18 Engineering Students from Dean/Engineering on 14-8-2022

Dear E/18 Engineering students,

I write this brief letter to clarify matters related to your Semester #3 exam.

- (1) This is with reference to your letters to Dean/Engineering through the ESU, dated 18-7-2022 and 12-8-2022
- (2) Based on your first letter dated 18-7-2022, I made a request from the Director/ITCGU to table a status report to the Faculty Board, related to the extension of the training period. A PDF copy of the letter by Dir/ITCGU is attached for your reference.
- (3) According to that letter NO students are officially in Industrial Training after 19-8-2022.
- (4) Therefore, I kindly request students who had 3 weeks of “dead week” after the Industrial Training (from 1-8-2022 to 19-8-2022) to sit for the exam to be started on 22-8-2022.
- (5) For those students who had to continue training till 19-8-2022 due to various reasons can be given the below concession subjected to the approval of the Faculty Board. **Consider their sitting to the next available exam as the first attempt.**
- (6) We need to conduct academic work for Semesters 3, 5 and 6 parallel and as a result, there is no way of rescheduling this exam in the near future.
- (7) Further, this exam was previously scheduled with 3 weeks of “dead weeks” after your Semester 4 exams, from 11-4-2022 to 20-5-2022, and you have left the exams in a very inappropriate manner after facing only few subjects. It is NOT possible for the faculty administration to give 3 weeks of “Dead Weeks” every time you want to sit for the same exam as this affects the progress of other batches.
- (8) Therefore, I kindly request you to take this opportunity given by the faculty in a positive manner and sit for the exams starting from 22-8-2022.
