## SPECIAL STUDENTS GUIDELINES FOR SITTING EXAMINATION UNDER COIVD-19 HEALTH GUIDELINES – JULY 2020

- 1. Candidates should reach the examination hall 45 hrs before the scheduled time of the examination.
- 2. Mask should be worn properly by all students at all times.
- 3. Facilities for hand washing with soap /sanitizers are provided at the entrance of the examination hall. Students should wash their hands for at least 20 seconds following correct steps before queuing for entering the examination hall.
- 4. Students should queue in designated lines one after the other keeping the minimum one meter physical distancing.
- 5. Students will be permitted to enter the examination hall one by one in an orderly manner. Follow the instructions of the supervisor/invigilator.
- 6. More than one meter physical distancing should be maintained at all times.
- 7. Students should maintain respiratory etiquette at all times and at all places.
- 8. Direct verbal communication should be avoided to the maximum and other modes of communication should be used.
- 9. Any student who has fever with/without respiratory symptoms should not attend for the examination and inform Assistant Registrar/Engineering immediately.
- 10. Exchange of pen, pencil, eraser and any other material between candidates is not allowed at the examination hall.
- 11. Bags, Books and notes etc. of candidates are not allowed in to the examination hall and should be kept in the allocated place. Anyhow, notes/books will be allowed for open-book examinations, please check with the supervisor/invigilation staff.
- 12. To avoid overcrowding, students shall only be permitted to leave the examination hall only in batches. Follow such instructions given and collect your belonging with no rushing after the examination.
- 13. Leave the examination hall area soon after the completion of examination.
